- IT department

- Center for Safety & Quality
- Purchasing

Goal was key stakeholder buy-in to decision, not lab-only buy-in.

Selection & Strategy



- Improve patient identification with tracking system
- Improve compliance and document control
- Software /IT /Reports
- Clinical Excellence –Turnaround Time
- Workflow Efficiencies Ease of use for personnel/Employee Engagement
- Financial Opportunities Consolidate processes
- Continuing Education
- Long term partner /growth opportunities
- Implement a specimen tracking system to prevent misdiagnosis

We looked beyond price and focused on patient safety, long term site impact and partnership

Process Review



- Identification errors how many? Goal: correct errors early in the processing lifecycle.
- Clinical outcome improvements.
- Productivity data for histotechs
- Better med-mal defense: "Got our bases covered"
- ▶ 25% Fewer recuts
- Less QA administration concentrate on fixing rather than data collection
